

# "Give Uganda's Children the Gift of Education - Butebo District Initiative"

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

American Aid, an IRS-registered 501(c)(3) organization, seeks to implement a comprehensive education and community development program in Butebo District, Uganda. This initiative aims to support 500 orphaned and vulnerable children while empowering widowed mothers through sustainable development programs.

## PROJECT OVERVIEW

Location: Butebo District, Uganda
