



Eid al-Adha Qurbani Project – Noor Rehabilitation Center

Project Overview

Noor Rehabilitation Center is launching the 'Eid of Dignity 2025' project to provide Qurbani meat to 400 vulnerable families in the Bethlehem area, specifically in Aida and Al-Azza refugee camps. The project focuses on supporting families of children with disabilities and other households living in extreme poverty.

Objectives

- Distribute fresh, halal Qurbani meat to 400 families during Eid al-Adha.
- Promote compassion and dignity among the most vulnerable groups.
- Raise awareness of the needs of families with children with disabilities.

Budget Summary

Total Estimated Budget: \$27,500

Breakdown:

- \$22,000 – Purchase of livestock (55 sheep at \$400 each)
- \$3,000 – Slaughtering, packaging, and transport
- \$1,000 – Distribution logistics and supplies
- \$1,500 – Project management and operational costs

Timeline

- June 1 – July 5, 2025: Fundraising Campaign
- July 5 – July 15, 2025: Procurement and Coordination
- July 16 – 18, 2025: Slaughter and Distribution
- July 25, 2025: Final Report Submission

Potential Long-Term Impact

This project strengthens social inclusion and community cohesion by supporting underprivileged families. It also fosters long-term relationships with donors and partners, laying the groundwork for sustainable development programs.
