# OUR MANDATE

Nazhoen Lamtoen employs a multi-faceted approach to child welfare, protection and reintegration:

**Child Protection and Advocacy:** Preventing and responding to child abuse, neglect, and exploitation through legal support, awareness campaigns, and community engagement.

**Psychosocial and Mental Health Support:** Ensuring access to counseling, therapy, and emotional well-being services for affected children.

**Rehabilitation and Reintegration for children in conflict with the law:** Providing mental health services, life skills training, and livelihood support to help children reintegrate into society.

**Support Livelihood Development:** Facilitating economic opportunities for families to prevent reoffending and ensure stability and sustainability for children in vulnerable situations.

**Residential Care and Rehabilitation:** Operating interim homes such as the Nazhoen Lamtoen Children's Halfway Home for children in need of shelter, aid, support and care.

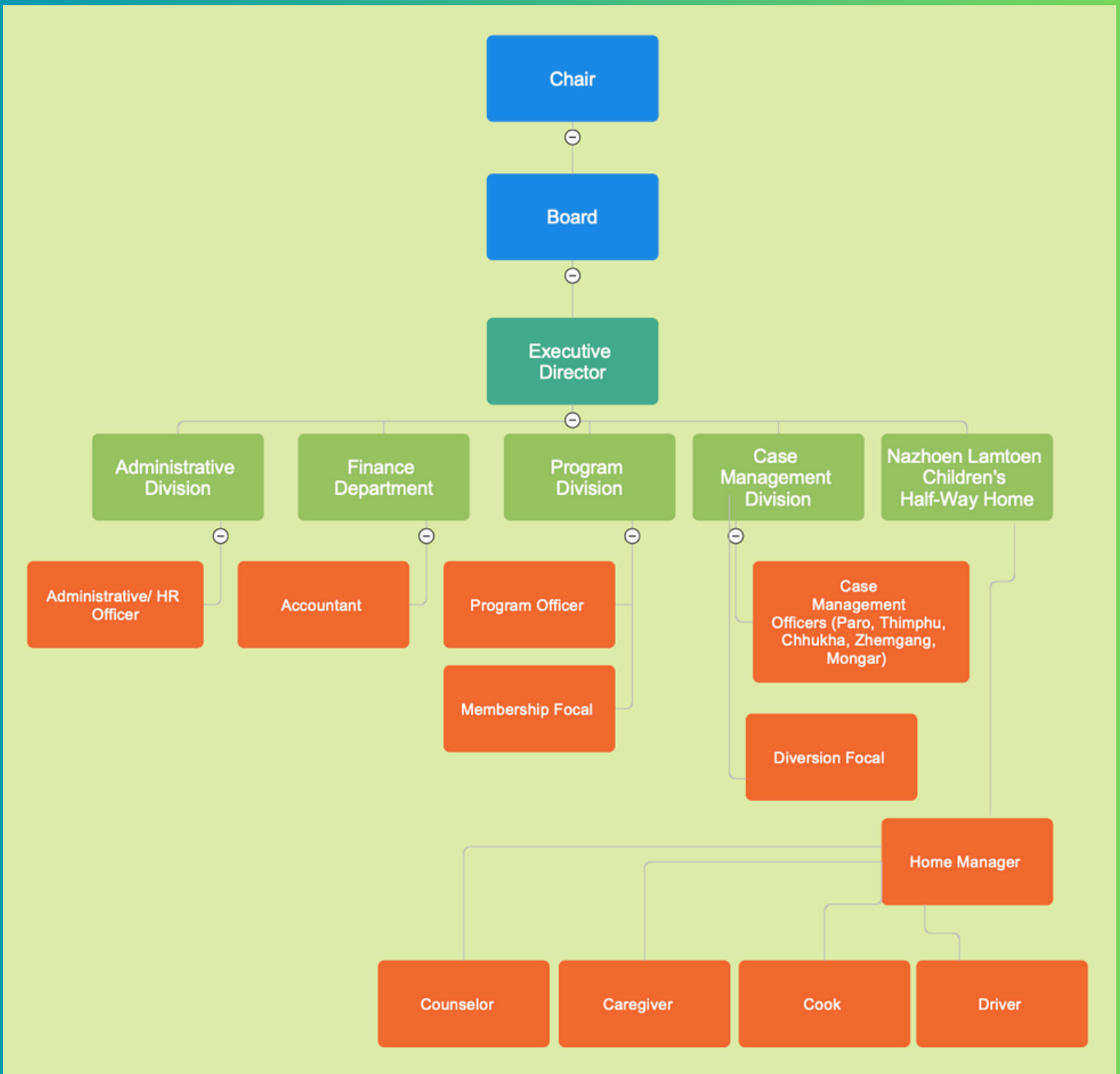
**Diversion Services:** Implementing alternative measures to judicial proceedings for children in conflict with the law, as per the Child Care and Protection Act of Bhutan.

**Education and Capacity Building:** Ensuring that every child has access to quality education, life skills training, and vocational opportunities to help them build a sustainable future.

**Community-Based Protection:** Establishing Community Child Protection Teams to foster safe environments and prevent child exploitation and abuse.

**Partnerships & Stakeholder Engagement:** Collaborating with government agencies, legal bodies, NGOs, and community leaders to strengthen child protection frameworks.

## *COMMUNITY MAPPING DIVERSION PROGRAM IN TASHIGANG, TSIRANG, AND SARPANG*

NAZHOEN LAMTOEN IS PROUD TO ANNOUNCE THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF ITS COMMUNITY MAPPING DIVERSION PROGRAM IN THE DISTRICTS OF TASHIGANG, TSIRANG, AND SARPANG. THIS MARKS A SIGNIFICANT MILESTONE IN THE ORGANIZATION'S EFFORTS TO PROMOTE CHILD-FRIENDLY JUSTICE, WITH DIVERSION PROGRAMS NOW IMPLEMENTED IN 11 DISTRICTS ACROSS BHUTAN.

THE DIVERSION PROGRAM OFFERS AN ALTERNATIVE APPROACH TO HANDLING CHILDREN IN CONFLICT WITH THE LAW (CICL), MOVING BEYOND THE TRADITIONAL JUDICIAL PROCESS TO FOCUS ON RESTORATIVE AND REHABILITATIVE MEASURES. THE PRIMARY GOAL IS TO PREVENT CHILDREN'S ENTRY INTO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM, ENSURING THAT THEY ARE SUPPORTED, GUIDED, AND REINTEGRATED INTO SOCIETY IN A POSITIVE AND CONSTRUCTIVE MANNER.

SINCE ITS INCEPTION, NAZHOEN LAMTOEN HAS DELIVERED SUPPORT SERVICES TO OVER 50 CICL, REFLECTING THE PROGRAM'S GROWING REACH AND IMPACT. THIS SUCCESS WOULD NOT HAVE BEEN POSSIBLE WITHOUT THE STRONG COLLABORATION OF KEY STAKEHOLDERS. THE PROGRAM BROUGHT TOGETHER REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE ROYAL BHUTAN POLICE, JUDICIARY, EDUCATION SECTOR, HEALTH SECTOR, CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS , GEWOG LEADERS, AND COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER GROUPS.

## *WINTER ENGAGEMENT PROGRAM (ART) – NURTURING CREATIVITY AND POSITIVE YOUTH ENGAGEMENT IN ZHEMGANG*

FROM 25<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY TO 8<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY 2024, THE SERENE LANDSCAPES OF ZHEMGANG WERE FILLED WITH COLOR, CREATIVITY, AND YOUTHFUL ENERGY AS THE WINTER ENGAGEMENT PROGRAM (ART) UNFOLDED. ORGANIZED AS PART OF A BROADER INITIATIVE TO KEEP YOUNG MINDS ENGAGED DURING THE WINTER BREAK, THE PROGRAM OFFERED CHILDREN A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY TO EXPLORE THEIR CREATIVITY, BUILD CONFIDENCE, AND CONNECT WITH PEERS THROUGH ART.

THE WINTER ENGAGEMENT PROGRAM WAS DESIGNED WITH A CLEAR PURPOSE: TO PROVIDE A SAFE AND STIMULATING ENVIRONMENT FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH DURING THE SCHOOL HOLIDAYS, ENCOURAGING THEM TO EXPRESS THEMSELVES THROUGH ARTISTIC ACTIVITIES WHILE PROMOTING PERSONAL GROWTH AND POSITIVE ENGAGEMENT. WITH STRUCTURED SESSIONS FOCUSED ON PAINTING, DRAWING, AND MIXED-MEDIA WORK, THE PROGRAM SERVED AS A NURTURING PLATFORM FOR PARTICIPANTS TO EXPLORE NEW SKILLS AND DISCOVER THE JOY OF CREATIVE EXPRESSION. THE PROGRAM SAW THE ENTHUSIASTIC PARTICIPATION OF OVER 60 YOUNG INDIVIDUALS, WHO ATTENDED DAILY SESSIONS FILLED WITH VIBRANT COLORS AND IMAGINATIVE IDEAS.

THE ARTWORKS THEY PRODUCED REFLECTED POWERFUL THEMES OF COMMUNITY, ENVIRONMENT, DREAMS, AND IDENTITY—OFFERING A MEANINGFUL WINDOW INTO THEIR THOUGHTS AND ASPIRATIONS.

BEYOND ARTISTIC DEVELOPMENT, THE PROGRAM FOSTERED A STRONG SENSE OF COMMUNITY AMONG PARTICIPANTS, FACILITATORS, AND LOCAL LEADERS. IT CREATED A SPACE WHERE CHILDREN FELT VALUED, HEARD, AND SUPPORTED—A PLACE WHERE THEIR POTENTIAL WAS CELEBRATED.

AS THE PROGRAM CONCLUDED, IT LEFT BEHIND MORE THAN JUST BEAUTIFUL ARTWORK. IT LEFT A LASTING IMPACT ON THE HEARTS AND MINDS OF THE YOUTH INVOLVED. THE SUCCESS OF THE WINTER ENGAGEMENT PROGRAM IN ZHEMGANG STANDS AS A TESTAMENT TO WHAT CAN BE ACHIEVED WHEN COMMUNITIES, CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS, AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS COME TOGETHER FOR A COMMON CAUSE: INVESTING IN THE FUTURE OF OUR CHILDREN.

### *EMPOWERING FUTURES: EXPOSURE VISIT FOR YOUTH DEVELOPMENT AND REHABILITATION CENTER RESIDENTS*

IN A CONTINUED EFFORT TO SUPPORT THE HOLISTIC DEVELOPMENT AND SUCCESSFUL REINTEGRATION OF CHILDREN IN CONFLICT WITH THE LAW, NAZHOEN LAMTOEN, IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE ROYAL BHUTAN POLICE AND UNICEF BHUTAN, FACILITATED A WEEK-LONG EXPOSURE AND LEARNING VISIT FOR RESIDENTS OF THE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT AND REHABILITATION CENTER (YDRC). THE FIELD VISIT WAS HELD FROM 25<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY TO 1<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2024 AND FOCUSED ON CAREER EXPLORATION, PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT, AND LIFE SKILLS ENHANCEMENT.

DURING THE VISIT, THE RESIDENTS WERE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO EXPLORE SEVERAL PREMIER VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL INSTITUTES IN BHUTAN, INCLUDING THE IBEST INSTITUTE, TECHNICAL TRAINING INSTITUTE IN THIMPHU, DE-SUUNG SKILLING AND TRAINING CENTRE, AND THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE FOR ZORIG CHUSUM. THESE VISITS PROVIDED A VALUABLE FIRST-HAND LOOK AT DIVERSE SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS, HELPING THE YOUTH UNDERSTAND THE PATHWAYS AVAILABLE TO THEM FOR PERSONAL AND PROFESSIONAL GROWTH AFTER THEIR TIME AT THE CENTER. BEYOND VOCATIONAL EXPOSURE, THE WEEK ALSO INCLUDED A SERIES OF STRUCTURED SESSIONS FOCUSED ON CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT AND WELL-BEING. THESE INCLUDED:

- A WELL-BEING SESSION DESIGNED TO SUPPORT EMOTIONAL RESILIENCE AND SELF-AWARENESS;
- A SESSION ON DRIGLAM NAMZHA, BHUTAN'S CODE OF ETIQUETTE AND CULTURAL VALUES;
- AN INFORMATIVE SESSION ON THE MITIGATION AND PREVENTION OF SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS;
- A SESSION ON CHILD RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES, WHICH REINFORCED THEIR UNDERSTANDING OF THEIR LEGAL RIGHTS AND ROLES AS ACTIVE MEMBERS OF SOCIETY.

THESE SESSIONS AIMED TO EQUIP THE RESIDENTS NOT ONLY WITH KNOWLEDGE BUT WITH THE VALUES AND CONFIDENCE THEY NEED TO REINTEGRATE INTO THEIR COMMUNITIES WITH DIGNITY AND PURPOSE.

THE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT AND REHABILITATION CENTER, ESTABLISHED UNDER THE VISIONARY COMMAND OF HIS MAJESTY THE FOURTH DRUK GYALPO, HAS LONG SERVED AS A TRANSFORMATIVE SPACE WHERE YOUNG INDIVIDUALS ARE GIVEN THE CHANCE TO REFORM AND REBUILD THEIR LIVES. WHILE AT THE CENTER, RESIDENTS RECEIVE ACCESS TO BOTH FORMAL EDUCATION AND SKILL-BUILDING OPPORTUNITIES THAT PREPARE THEM FOR LIFE BEYOND ITS WALLS.

### *EMPOWERING THROUGH LIVELIHOOD: JANGPHUTSE SCHOOL SALOON CLUB LAUNCHED IN TASHIYANGTSE*

IN A HEARTENING INITIATIVE AIMED AT SUPPORTING CHILDREN IN NEED, THE JANGPHUTSE SCHOOL SALOON CLUB WAS OFFICIALLY LAUNCHED IN TASHIYANGTSE. THIS INNOVATIVE SCHOOL-BASED LIVELIHOOD PROJECT IS DESIGNED NOT ONLY TO EQUIP STUDENTS WITH PRACTICAL SKILLS BUT ALSO TO GENERATE INCOME THAT WILL BE REINVESTED BACK INTO THE SCHOOL TO FURTHER SUPPORT VULNERABLE CHILDREN. THE INITIATIVE HAS BEEN MADE POSSIBLE WITH GENEROUS FUNDING SUPPORT FROM SOCIETY SWITZERLAND BHUTAN.

THE SALOON CLUB STANDS AS A TESTAMENT TO THE POWER OF COMMUNITY-DRIVEN SOLUTIONS. IT OFFERS STUDENTS AN OPPORTUNITY TO ENGAGE IN HANDS-ON LEARNING, BUILD VOCATIONAL SKILLS, AND SIMULTANEOUSLY CONTRIBUTE TO A SOCIAL CAUSE. ALL PROCEEDS GENERATED THROUGH THE SALOON SERVICES WILL BE DIRECTED TOWARD PROVIDING EDUCATIONAL AND MATERIAL SUPPORT FOR CHILDREN FACING DIFFICULT CIRCUMSTANCES WITHIN THE SCHOOL.

## CASE REPORT #1 OF 160

A FAMILY FACING DIFFICULT CIRCUMSTANCES HAS FOUND NEW HOPE THROUGH A LIVELIHOOD INTERVENTION PROGRAM AIMED AT SUPPORTING CHILDREN IN NEED. PEMA (NAME CHANGED), A 39-YEAR-OLD SINGLE MOTHER, IS RAISING FOUR CHILDREN WITHOUT ANY MEANS OF STABLE INCOME TO SUSTAIN THEIR EDUCATION. PRIOR TO RECEIVING OUR INTERVENTION, THE FAMILY RELIED ON COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE TO SURVIVE.

NAZHOEN LAMTOEN'S CASE MANAGEMENT SUPPORT FOCUSES ON HELPING FAMILIES LIKE PEMA'S, WHO ARE IN CHALLENGING SITUATIONS, BY PROVIDING LONG-TERM LIVELIHOOD ASSISTANCE. THE GOAL IS TO EMPOWER THESE FAMILIES, ENABLING THEM TO ACHIEVE SELF-RELIANCE AND IMPROVE THEIR QUALITY OF LIFE. FOR PEMA, THE INTRODUCTION OF A SMALL GROCERY SHOP HAS PROVEN TO BE A PIVOTAL INTERVENTION.

THIS SMALL BUSINESS IS ALREADY GENERATING PROFITS THAT ARE DIRECTED TOWARDS THE WELFARE OF PEMA'S CHILDREN. TO ENSURE THAT THE SUPPORT REMAINS SUSTAINABLE, OUR DEDICATED CASE MANAGER OVERSEES THE PROCESS AND REQUIRES THAT FAMILIES BENEFITING FROM THE PROGRAM CONTRIBUTE NU. 2000 FROM THE BUSINESS PROFITS TOWARDS THE WELL-BEING OF THE CHILDREN. THIS CONTRIBUTION HELPS ENSURE THAT THE CHILDREN'S NEEDS, INCLUDING EDUCATION AND HEALTHCARE, ARE MET. THE SUCCESS OF THIS INTERVENTION IS NOT JUST IN THE FINANCIAL STABILITY IT PROVIDES BUT IN ITS POTENTIAL TO EMPOWER FAMILIES TO BREAK THE CYCLE OF DEPENDENCY AND WORK TOWARDS A BRIGHTER, MORE INDEPENDENT FUTURE. PEMA'S STORY IS A TESTAMENT TO THE POWER OF COMMUNITY SUPPORT AND THE TRANSFORMATIVE IMPACT OF LIVELIHOOD ASSISTANCE IN CREATING LASTING CHANGE.

## CASE REPORT #2 OF 160

IN DAGANA, A FAMILY FACING DIFFICULT CIRCUMSTANCES HAS BEEN GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO OWN A HARDWARE SHOP, MARKING A SIGNIFICANT TURNING POINT IN THEIR LIVES. THIS IS NOT JUST A BUSINESS ENDEAVOR; IT IS A LIFELINE, OFFERING HOPE FOR A BRIGHTER FUTURE, PARTICULARLY FOR THE CHILDREN.

THE SUPPORT EXTENDED TO THIS FAMILY IS A TESTAMENT TO THE POWER OF COMMUNITY SOLIDARITY. THE CLOSE-KNIT COMMUNITY CAME TOGETHER, RALLYING AROUND ONE OF THEIR OWN TO PROVIDE CRUCIAL LIVELIHOOD SUPPORT. 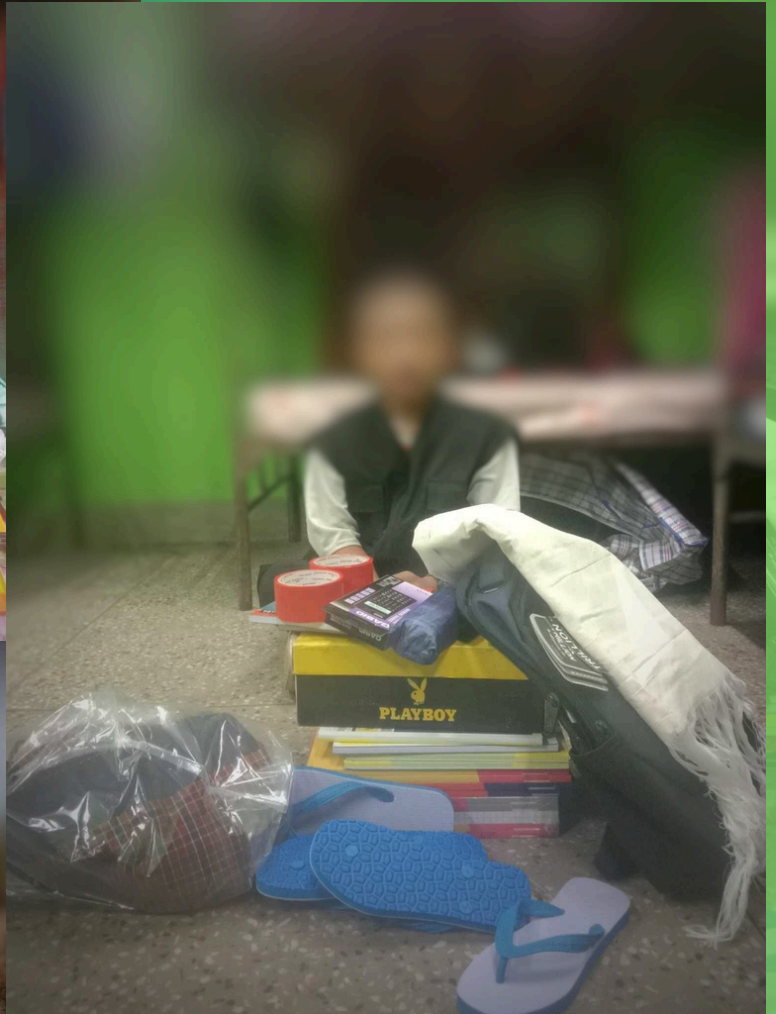

# STRATEGIC GOALS FOR 2025

## **1/ STRENGTHENING CASE MANAGEMENT AND REHABILITATION SERVICES:**

EXPANDING OUR CASE MANAGEMENT SUPPORT IS A KEY FOCUS. WE AIM TO PROVIDE MORE PERSONALIZED INTERVENTIONS FOR CHILDREN AND FAMILIES, ESPECIALLY THOSE WHO ARE MOST AT RISK. WE WILL ALSO ENHANCE OUR REHABILITATION SERVICES, ENSURING SUCCESSFUL REINTEGRATION FOR CHILDREN TRANSITIONING FROM OUR CHILDREN'S HALFWAY HOME INTO THEIR COMMUNITIES AND SCHOOLS.

## **2/ INCREASING COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AND AWARENESS:**

WE WILL EXPAND COMMUNITY OUTREACH TO RAISE AWARENESS ON CHILD WELFARE ISSUES AND PROMOTE THE SAFEGUARDING OF CHILDREN'S RIGHTS. BY ENGAGING WITH LOCAL COMMUNITIES, SCHOOLS, AND AUTHORITIES, WE AIM TO BUILD A COLLECTIVE RESPONSIBILITY FOR PROTECTING AND EMPOWERING CHILDREN, ESPECIALLY IN RURAL AND UNDERSERVED AREAS.

## **3/ ADVOCATING FOR CHILD PROTECTION LEGISLATION AND POLICY REFORM:**

STRENGTHENING CHILD PROTECTION LAWS REMAINS A PRIORITY. WE WILL ADVOCATE FOR STRONGER LEGISLATION AND MORE EFFECTIVE ENFORCEMENT TO SAFEGUARD CHILDREN'S RIGHTS. THIS INCLUDES WORKING CLOSELY WITH GOVERNMENT BODIES, PARLIAMENTARIANS, AND OTHER STAKEHOLDERS TO PROMOTE MEANINGFUL POLICY REFORM.

## **4/ FORMATION OF CHILD PROTECTION TEAMS IN MARGINALIZED AREAS:**

A SIGNIFICANT GOAL FOR THE YEAR IS THE FORMATION OF CHILD PROTECTION TEAMS IN SECLUDED AND RURAL AREAS OF BHUTAN, WHERE ACCESS TO CHILD PROTECTION SERVICES IS LIMITED. THESE TEAMS WILL BE TRAINED TO IDENTIFY, RESPOND TO, AND PREVENT CHILD ABUSE, NEGLECT, AND EXPLOITATION. THEY WILL SERVE AS A SUPPORT SYSTEM, ENSURING THAT EVERY CHILD, REGARDLESS OF WHERE THEY LIVE, HAS ACCESS TO PROTECTION SERVICES AND ADVOCACY.

# STRATEGIC GOALS FOR 2025

## **5/ STRENGTHENING PARTNERSHIPS AND COLLABORATION:**

STRENGTHENING AND BUILDING NEW PARTNERSHIPS WILL BE VITAL TO ENHANCING OUR IMPACT. WE WILL WORK CLOSELY WITH GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, LOCAL NGOS, INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS LIKE SAVE THE CHILDREN BHUTAN AND UNICEF, AND COMMUNITY-BASED GROUPS TO PROVIDE COMPREHENSIVE SUPPORT TO CHILDREN IN NEED.

## **6/ ENHANCING MONITORING AND EVALUATION SYSTEMS**

TO ENSURE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF OUR PROGRAMS, WE WILL FOCUS ON STRENGTHENING OUR MONITORING AND EVALUATION SYSTEMS. THIS WILL INCLUDE BETTER TRACKING OF PROGRAM OUTCOMES, GATHERING FEEDBACK FROM CHILDREN AND COMMUNITIES, AND USING DATA TO CONTINUALLY REFINE AND IMPROVE OUR INTERVENTIONS.

## **7/ EXPANDING LIVELIHOOD SUPPORT AND EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMS**

EMPOWERING FAMILIES TO BECOME SELF-RELIANT IS KEY TO LONG-TERM CHILD WELFARE. WE WILL INTRODUCE MORE INCOME-GENERATING PROGRAMS AND LIVELIHOOD SUPPORT INITIATIVES, PROVIDING TRAINING AND RESOURCES TO HELP FAMILIES ACHIEVE FINANCIAL INDEPENDENCE, WHICH IN TURN SUPPORTS THEIR CHILDREN'S WELL-BEING.

BY FOCUSING ON THESE STRATEGIC GOALS, NAZHOEN LAMTOEN AIMS TO CREATE A LASTING AND POSITIVE CHANGE IN THE LIVES OF CHILDREN ACROSS BHUTAN, ENSURING THAT THEY ARE SUPPORTED, PROTECTED, AND EMPOWERED TO REACH THEIR FULL POTENTIAL. WE ARE EXCITED FOR THE YEAR AHEAD AND THANK ALL OF OUR PARTNERS AND SUPPORTERS FOR THEIR DEDICATION TO THE WELFARE OF CHILDREN.
