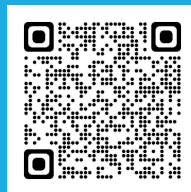

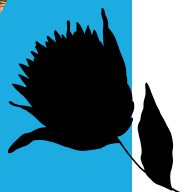

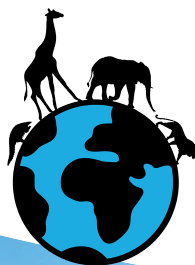


OUR FOCUS
