

# Help Rongjiang Children Rise: Flood Relief

Our mission is to empower disadvantaged children in rural China through philanthropic English education initiatives and scholarships.

On June 26, 2025, Rongjiang (population 300,000) was hit by record rainfall, killing six and displacing over 80,000 people. Two days later, more heavy rain dropped floodwaters up to two meters above danger level, half-submerging the city and forcing another 40,000 residents to evacuate. Students under 18 are now unable to attend school, missing classes, and living in unsafe or temporary housing—causing disruption to education, stability, and emotional wellbeing.

Our new project with the goal of raising 10,000 US dollars is designed to help students regain stability, health, and access to education after the floods. By providing food vouchers, we restore dignity and support local businesses. Hygiene kits will reduce illness and prevent school absences. Shelter kits ensure safe living conditions. School supplies will enable classrooms to resume. Together, these interventions will reverse flood-related disruptions and rebuild students' routines, resilience, and hope.

We will work closely with local government agencies and community organizations in Rongjiang to ensure funds reach children most in need. By coordinating with education authorities, relief teams, and local leaders on the ground, we guarantee that every dollar delivers school supplies, hygiene kits, temporary shelter, and food vouchers to the students who need them most—efficiently, transparently, and with local oversight.
