



Panpandiar School Promise Project

Project Context and History

The **Panpandiar School Promise Project** is a **new initiative** led by the South Sudan Hope Network (SSHN) that builds upon a strong track record of completed community development efforts in South Sudan.

While this specific project is newly launched and seeking full funding for implementation, SSHN has already successfully:

- **Built schools** in Panpandiar and Tot using local labor and international donor support
- **Shipped essential supplies** such as educational materials, uniforms, and tools
- **Fostered youth-led fundraising** (e.g., Girl Scouts in the U.S. contributing to school construction)
- **Collaborated with village elders and community leaders** to prioritize sustainable infrastructure projects

The **Panpandiar Promise** is a natural next step, informed by on-the-ground assessments and years of relationship-building. This 3-phase project will provide:

1. **A Clean Water Well** near the school
2. **A Daily Nutrition Program** to address student hunger and improve attendance
3. **Girls' Empowerment Initiatives**, including hygiene kits, health education, and support groups

Though the **project has not yet commenced**, all planning is complete, the community is mobilized, and SSHN is ready to implement upon securing funding.
