2. Executive Summary

This project provides free legal aid, civil registration for displaced children, and paralegal training for youth and women in Mozambique. By defending rights and strengthening community resilience, AAAJC empowers vulnerable families to access services, reduce exclusion, and influence policies for inclusive development.

3. Problem Statement

Mozambique's vulnerable communities face land conflicts, lack of civil registration, and limited access to justice. Displaced children remain undocumented, excluding them from education and health services. Families suffer exploitation and denial of basic rights, while weak institutional coordination leaves them without protection. This project targets these groups to restore dignity and resilience.

4. Proposed Solution

- **Free Legal Aid:** Mobile clinics, mediation, and defense in land, labor, and education cases.
- **Civil Registration Campaigns:** Document displaced children to ensure access to essential services.
- **Paralegal Training:** Train 100 youth and women as community paralegals to expand local legal literacy.
- **Institutional Partnerships:** Collaborate with justice institutions to ensure accountability and policy change.

5. Expected Results & Long-Term Impact

- **By 2027:**
 - 500 legal cases resolved.
 - 2,000 children registered.
 - 100 paralegals trained.
- **Impact:** Stronger resilience, reduced exclusion, improved access to rights.
- **Long-Term:** Families live with dignity, youth lead justice initiatives, and communities thrive inclusively.
