# The Reality for Children and Youth in Rural Communities (Valle de Bravo, Estado de México)

- Limited access to electricity, running water, and internet in many schools
- Long distances and unsafe routes to school → higher absenteeism and dropout
- Limited learning materials and outdated infrastructure
- Gender-based violence and early pregnancy affecting girls' opportunities
- Few socioemotional support services or safe spaces for youth
- Low academic achievement due to structural barriers, not ability
- Limited pathways to higher education, skills training, or local employment

# What Our Educators (PEMs) Do Every Day

Your support funds part of our Enseña por México Leadership Program in which our educators (PEM) become leaders within the community that:

- Co-create solutions with communities, from water access, solar panels and wifi installation, to workshops on gender violence or early pregnancy prevention.
- Create enriched and engaging learning environments.
- Support school needs through reading reinforcement, socioemotional learning, and academic strengthening.
- Work closely with families and caregivers to build trust and strengthen community participation.
- Design learning experiences that reflect local culture, language, and reality.
- Promote safe, respectful, and inclusive school spaces.
