

International Health Partners (IHP) is closely monitoring the devastating situation unfolding in the Middle East, with a focus on Lebanon, where we work closely with several humanitarian partners.

On the 2nd of March 2026, hostilities in Lebanon escalated, with intense airstrikes across multiple areas north and south of the Litani River. The Lebanese Ministry of Public Health has reported 31 deaths and over 149 injuries to date, with numbers continuing to rise ([MoPH](#)). The new attacks triggered an estimated 29,000 people displaced (of which 9,000 are children) in the first 24 hours alone, in addition to the previous 62,000 Internally Displaced People in general ([UNICEF](#)).

The situation in Lebanon was already dire, with essential infrastructures being destroyed, leading to increased public health risks. Impact on health services has been devastating, with over 40 hospitals and 98 primary health centres damaged or destroyed, and critical shortages of essential medicines and medical equipment have drastically reduced the ability to provide adequate patient care ([UNICEF](#)). The current escalation of conflict will only intensify the dire situation of the people in Lebanon.

At International Health Partners, our priority in any emergency is to ensure that the right medical and health supplies reach the people who need them most - quickly, responsibly, and in close coordination with trusted partners. .

IHP has already dispatched a large **consignment of primary healthcare medicines**, due to arrive shortly, capable of supporting more than **36,000 patients**. Additional shipments of **essential antibiotics** are scheduled to leave soon, with further medicines for **mental health care** in the pipeline as approvals are finalised.
