

Who We Are!

Fuel Relief Fund originated out of a quest to provide a fuel source for victims immediately following the devastation from a natural disaster.

In September 2005, Hurricane Katrina hit the Gulf States. Due to the lack of fuel, victims were unable to find the food, water, and shelter they required. For weeks and sometimes months, victims relied on generators for power.

In that time of need, two current board members sent a tanker truck filled with gasoline from California to Mississippi, and then to Louisiana. In both states, survivors were given free gasoline to run their automobiles and generators. Another truck was also dispatched after Hurricane Rita. These events prompted the creation of the non-profit organization called Fuel Relief Fund.

Since the founding of the organization in 2009, Fuel Relief Fund has responded to two more major disasters. The organization was in Haiti for 3 months providing diesel to fuel generators. This benefited countless people by powering lights, medical equipment, water, and communication systems to run. In 2011, Fuel Relief Fund was in Japan for almost two months donating fuel, in the form of heating oil. It was given away in the most devastated areas where Fuel Relief Fund estimates to have kept about 50,000 people warm during freezing nights.

Fuel needs to be a major factor in any well thought out disaster plan. Fuel Relief Fund knows that the basic essentials of life... food, water, shelter, and fuel will be needed. By providing the latter, we help relieve some of the suffering during extremely difficult times.

Mission Statement

Fuel Relief Fund's mission is to bring together necessary resources to provide temporary fuel assistance to the victims in a recently stricken disaster area and to provide fuel cards to those people who find themselves in dire need during the year.



Fuel Relief Fund was in Haiti in 2010, immediately following the earthquake, to distribute free fuel to tent cities, medical clinics, orphanages, and police stations.



In May of 2010, tornadoes killed over 20 people in Oklahoma. Fuel Relief Fund distributed free fuel cards to the people who were seriously affected by the tornadoes and was able to help in the recovery process.
